The **CARPET** project information platform on scientific electronic publishing is available online as of April 30, 2009: www.carpet-project.net. A catalogue that lists tools and services for electronic publishing is the basis of the platform. Users can search the catalogue and retrieve information on existing software developments and applications here. CARPET aims to enhance the sustainability of project developments by presenting them on the platform, and to offer a central entry point for ePublishing activities.

Catalogue of Tools
and Services

The catalogue of tools and services provides an opportunity for users to find appropriate developments for their particular publication project. Software developers and service providers can submit information on new applications using a web form on the site.

Communication Portal

Since CARPET also strives to become a communication portal in the field of electronic publishing, a first general feedback form as well as a tool specific comment feature has been implemented. These shall assist in continuously improving the platform and connecting users, providers and developers to enable collaborative work and identify development gaps and needs.

Further Development
of the Portal

The information portal and catalogue will be constantly developed further. It is planned to extend the search by thematic browsing as well as to provide context sensitive help on basic topics. Best-practice recommendations and guidelines for standards and interoperability will be made available, and shall thus serve as a basis for new, generic developments.
